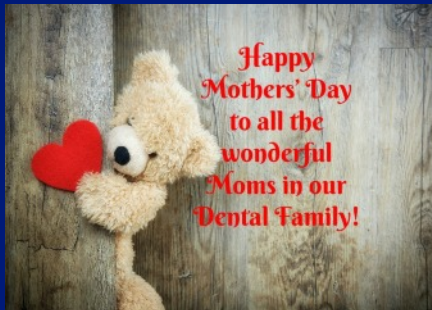

Healthy Smiles Are Beautiful Smiles

Do you dodge out of the frame of a group picture? Maybe you drop your head or turn away when speaking, or cover your mouth with your hand when you laugh. Has it been a long time since you smiled into the mirror and liked what you saw? Then you have probably been searching the internet for a doctor "near me" to trust with your cosmetic dentistry concerns. Dr. Bob Foster can help you.

Every element of a healthy mouth contributes to a beautiful smile. For instance, gum disease leads to puffy, discolored soft tissues. When the gums recede, the teeth look too long. As yellowish root surfaces are exposed, they may develop visible decay. Eventually, teeth fall out. The lower portion of the face collapses inward from bone loss. That draws the corners of the mouth down and allows the skin to droop into wrinkles. In addition, missing, broken, worn-down, or misaligned teeth disrupt the beautiful symmetry that we find appealing.

So, under Dr. Foster care, your oral health is addressed first. Like all sound structures, you must begin with the basics.

What can Cosmetic Dentistry Fix?

Here are some smile flaws that we can correct with cosmetic dentistry:

Size - Teeth that look too big or small, too long or short as compared to the neighboring teeth, or the size of your mouth.

Shape - A naturally odd appearance with pits or bumps in enamel, or wear down from bruxism – grinding and clenching.

Color – Most children have gleaming white teeth. But, over the years, staining foods and beverages, tobacco, and negligent oral hygiene leave discoloration behind. Even medications and medical treatments may cause deep discoloration. Enamel naturally thins, too, allowing the yellow layer of dentin to show through.

Gaps – Some people have wide spaces between their teeth or gaps from missing or extracted teeth, or teeth missing in development.

Alignment – Spacing issues are caused by crowded teeth, overlapping teeth or teeth that have become crooked are common concerns.

Trauma – Stains are grabbed when enamel chips and fractures, and minor breakage and that can spoil your smile.

You will Need:

- 1 Popsicle Mold
- 2 Kiwis
- 2 Peaches
- 5 Strawberries
- 1/2 Cup Blueberries
- 2 16 oz bottles of flavored water

Instructions:

Cut the kiwi and strawberries into small slices. Cut the peaches into bite-sized pieces.

Add the fruit into the popsicle molds until each one is filled. Leave about 1/2 inch from the top.

Pour the flavored water into each mold filling until it reaches about 1/2 inch from the top.

Place the top of your popsicle stick mold on.

Now place in the freezer until frozen. Approximately 4-5 hours or overnight.
